Entry Specifications for Size and Quantity Have Changed. Please Read Carefully

These rules ensure there is enough space to display at least one piece per participating AVA member

2-AND 3-DIMENSIONAL ARTWORKS

Artists may submit two works of art for this exhibition. For fine craft items and multiples please see below.

- Wall pieces (in any medium) must be under 6' x 6'.
- Sculpture must be under 200 lbs.
- Diptychs and triptychs are considered a single piece, must adhere to the same size requirements listed above and be priced as one work.

FINE CRAFT ITEMS AND SHRINK WRAPPED MULTIPLES

- AVA may be able to accommodate multiple fine craft items and shrink wrapped pieces depending on size and scale of the works. Artists must coordinate directly with AVA's Exhibition Coordinator, Margaret Jacobs, prior to drop-off.

OTHER INFORMATION

- All work must arrive finished, completely dry and ready for display. AVA reserves the right to refuse work that does not meet these requirements.
- Wall pieces must be framed, when appropriate, and/or have adequate hangers or wire.
- Works that require specialized display or an unconventional method of presentation must be discussed with AVA's Exhibition Coordinator, Margaret Jacobs, prior to drop-off.
- All submitted shrink-wrapped multiples will be grouped together and replenished as sold.
- We cannot guarantee that submitted works will be displayed simultaneously; the exhibit will change as works are sold.
- All pedestals and display cases will be provided by AVA to create a visually cohesive look throughout the galleries.

AVA guarantees that at least one of your works will be exhibited if these guidelines are followed.
