*Drawing Materials List*

- Large newsprint paper pad (18 x 24") Please note the size!
- Large **Drawing** (smooth, white) paper pad (18x 24") Canson brand is suitable. Please note the size!
- HB (or F) graphite pencil & Soft charcoal pencils; 4B, 2B, or 6B
- Package of compressed charcoal (**Charkole** brand is my preference). You will go through a lot of this. These are rectangular sticks, soft and very dark.
- Vine charcoal (optional, just to try out)
- Hand-held pencil sharpener (or utility knife)
- Art Gum and Kneadable, erasers. Opt: Pink Pearl and/or magic rub eraser
- Chamois cloth
- Workable fixative
- **Water-based** Sumi Ink. (will explain in class, not needed in first week)
- Sumi brush (will explain in class, not needed in first week) Bamboo handle.. get the cheapest one you can.
- "O-Glue Stick" or equivalent (optional, will explain in class, not needed in first week)

You may bring pastels or the like for later in the term. We will discuss this in class. We may suggest other materials including small piece of plexiglass and sharpie marker, as the class progresses, but this works for the start.
