

## TUNNEL BOOKS

These structures are like small theaters, similar to the shoebox dioramas children make in school. We will use our own illustrations or images cut from magazines or other source material in our books. If you come with an idea or simple sketch for a small 3-dimensional world you want to create, you'll be well prepared to make the most from this workshop. Our tunnel books will be about 4" high x 6" wide, about the size of a postcard.

### **Minimum Tools:**

Pencil

Scissors

Metal ruler, 12"

X-acto knife, or other craft knife and extra blades, but NOT a boxcutter

Self healing cutting mat or a thick (not corrugated) piece of cardboard, like the back of a legal pad 4-6 smaller binder's clips, paper clips, or clothespins,

Glue stick, make sure it's not dried out!

Some kind of tape: masking, scotch or blue painter's tape Colored pencils, markers, fine black marker

30-50 sheets of 8.5 x 11 card stock, 110 lb is best, 80 lb would work okay, and 65 lb if that's all you can find (these are for the panels) some white and any colors you wish to use

10 sheets of 8.5 x 11 card stock, 65 lb, white or any colors (for the sides, they need to be folded, so that's why these sheets are thinner)

Old magazines, postcards, clip art, or other illustrations to cut out or you can draw your own illustrations

### **Optional tools:**

Bone folder
