

HALASKA PLEIN AIR OIL MATERIALS

- 1-2 8x10 and smaller painting surfaces, preferably the same size.

Paintings surfaces can be canvas/linen, gessoed panel, or oil paper. (I'm using Arches Oil Paper, 9 x 12 inch, and using tape to create two, 5 x 7 segments on each page for the smaller paintings, and a full 9x12 sheet for the larger painting.

-Oil paint, I recommend at least: titanium white, ultramarine blue, cadmium yellow light, cadmium red, and ivory black in 37ml tubes.

-Paint thinner, I recommend Gamsol

-Painting medium, I recommend Linseed oil or a premixed painting medium

-Paper towel or rag/cloth

-Brushes (I recommend a small, medium and large brush, bristle and soft haired brushes)

-Palette

-Palette knife

-Portable Easel if available (though AVA can also provide these)
