

AVA Sculptural Studies Building Bench Fees



- Billing for bench rental will be monthly, quarterly, semi-annually and annually.
- Discounts will be offered for the quarterly, semi-annual and annual payments.
- Sign-ups will be prorated to align with AVA's fiscal year, which begins Sept.
- Everyone must be an artist member = \$120/yr. This covers consumables costs

Stone Carving, Metal, and Wood

Annual bench rental fee is \$1500.00

Annual bench rental fee paid in full >> 15% discount = \$225 \$1,275/yr

Semi-annual fee (paid twice per year) >> 10% discount = \$150 \$1,350/yr
\$1,350 / 2 = \$675

Quarterly fee (paid four times per year)>> 5% discount= \$75 \$1,425/yr
\$1,425/4 = \$356.25

Monthly fee \$1,500/12 = \$125/month

Clay Studio Bench Fee:

- \$120 annual artist member's fee
- \$50/25lb of clay (Must be purchased from AVA; includes glazing and firing)
- \$20/25lbs of recycled clay
- All clay is Cone 6
- Thorough clean-up is always required (washing and drying tools and surfaces, mopping floor, putting away all tools in their appropriate places)
- Student participants must have the necessary skills to work safely and unsupervised and be approved by their instructor

Qualifications for Bench Rental

- Bench renters must be proficient in the use of any tool or machine that is needed to create their projects
- Wood Shop and Metal Shop bench renters must complete the following AVA courses
 - Wood Shop: Woodworking I-- Working with Hand tools and Woodworking II— Working with Machine Tools or the equivalent with approval of the Sculpture Program Manager with input from their instructor(s)
 - Metal Shop: Welding I and Welding II the equivalent with approval of the Sculpture Program Manager with input from their instructor(s)
 - Clay – Intro to Pottery + approval by their instructor
 - If a renter is unfamiliar with, or needs a refresher with any tool or machine, they must seek instruction from their teacher and the Sculpture Program Manager
 - If a renter misuses or damages tools or equipment because of lack of expertise or negligence, they may be required to repair/replace damaged equipment and/or have their bench rental privileges revoked
 - Everyone is expected to be courteous and respectful of their shop mates
