**A shortened list for those who want to try the class before investing a lot in materials.**

Pad of good quality watercolor paper (I like Arches watercolor paper)  
Watercolor Palette, you can use a plate  
I like the John Pike palette  
Water container – empty yogurt container

An eight or sixteen-pan student watercolor set made by Crayola or Reeves will work

**For those who are ready to invest and begin gathering materials:**

Arches Watercolor paper block

Winsor Newton watercolor tubes, it is good to at least have the following colors:

Alizarin Crimson	Pthalo Green
Ultramarine Blue	Burnt Sienna
Lemon Yellow or Aureolin Yellow	Payne's Gray
Sap Green	

Or : Pre-arranged tube set for students

Or : Winsor Newton travel set that doesn't have tubes but has small cakes of colors and folds up into a small case.

John Pike Palette or white plastic palette with ample mixing areas

Brushes: The brush that comes with the pan sets are small and cheap so it is good to get some good watercolor painting brushes.

Suggested sizes:

At least a#10 round

#6 or #8 round

Pencil and eraser

Water container

Paper towels
