

Harrison Halaska Acrylic Materials List

Five 11 x 14 inch surfaces (canvas or panel or heavy paper meant for paint are all fine; Creative Mark is a good brand)

Paints (Liquetex is a good brand):

250ml of:

- Cadmium Yellow light paint (or anything close to primary yellow)
- Cadmium red (or anything close to primary red)
- Ultramarine blue acrylic paint (or something close to primary blue.)
- Ivory black
- Titanium white

At least 2 large, medium, and small brushes. I enjoy using filberts, but square or round are great too. Synthetic is a great brush material and less expensive. But if you enjoy painting softer and blending natural hair is fine, and if you like things brushy looking bristle is great.

Scotch tape.

A can to trace a circle.

A pencil.

Palette knife.

A palette. I recommend a resealable palette box with grey palette paper. Not necessary but helpful with acrylic.

A container for water.

Paper towel or cloth for drying brushes.
