

Alla Prima Landscape Oil Painting Materials List:

- Sketchbook or paper, pencil
- black and gray markers
- Gray scale/value chart
- Small (12 inch) straight edge (an old credit card is also useful)

- Viewfinder, if you have one or we can make them

- 10x12 canvas panel or gessobord

- Variety of brushes for oils: (for example #4 and #8 bright, one #2 round or flat)

- Oil colors: titanium white, Hansa yellow light, alizarin crimson, ultramarine blue, and burnt sienna. It's fine to swap ultramarine for another deep blue like Prussian or phthalo blue. or use cadmium yellow light instead of the Hansa.

- Palette: most pochade boxes include a palette, but you can also use paper palettes. 'Grey Matters' is a good brand.

- easel or tripod to hold your panel and paintbox or palette

- Gamsol in a small glass container
- Paper towels (blue shop ones are best)
- Bag for used towels
- Hat
- Clip on umbrella if you have one

Note: we hope to be painting outside, so please be prepared with a painting set-up like a pochade box that attaches to a tripod and holds your palette and panel as we won't have tables, etc.
